

Promising signs from youngsters

Films made by deaf young people from around the region have been screened at a special ceremony in Bradford.

More than 150 young people attended the Yorkshire SignFilm Festival, organised by Bradford-based charity Youth Deafinitions, showcasing the work of deaf youngsters involved in all stages of film-making, from writing scripts to editing.

The young film-makers received awards at the National Media Museum.

Youth Deafinitions project worker Nageena Aurangzeb said: "As a deaf person, I've been told that I can't do this or that. This festival is an opportunity for deaf people to show what they can do."
